As I reflect on 2024, I am pleased to share the remarkable progress our foundation has achieved. We awarded tuition scholarships to 8 students for paramedic school, bringing our total scholarships granted to \$27,000. Our dedicated team of volunteers rigorously reviews applications to identify candidates who meet Bryant's and our standards for becoming exceptional paramedics. I firmly believe that Bryant is looking down on us with pride, knowing that we have been honoring his memory over the past 3 years and will continue doing so for many more.

For those who knew Bryant personally — whether as a colleague, teacher, coach, my husband, my best friend, father to our boys — or those who know of him through the foundation, he was an incredible teacher in addition to his roles within our family. I'm constantly amazed by those who express their gratitude for having been his students and how he transformed their lives. This impact extends further as they, in turn, touch others' lives by adhering to his golden rules: never repeat your first year (foster continual learning, learn from mistakes, and improve yourself) and treat everyone as Mrs. Smith (ensure everyone receives the same care and respect).

The mission of the Bryant Gladney Foundation is to inspire the next generation of outstanding EMS providers. As we move into 2025, we are committed to raising funds to provide 10 applicants (up from 8 in 2024) with \$1,500 scholarships each, helping to alleviate the financial burden for the best future paramedics. We are excited for our first All-Star EMS conference in Columbia, MO, on May 16-17, where we aim to further the education of EMTs and paramedics with industry leaders presenting topics that Bryant would have endorsed.

I want to express my deepest gratitude to our donors, students, supporters, partners, and volunteers for their unwavering support and trust. Together, we have built a strong foundation, and I am enthusiastic about the opportunities ahead. Thank you for your continued confidence in our foundation.

OUR STORY

In the early hours of December 22, 2021, Boone County Fire Protection District Assistant Chief Bryant Gladney responded to a motor vehicle accident on Interstate 70 just outside of Columbia, MO. He was the first fire department unit to arrive on scene in his staff vehicle and blocked a lane of traffic to protect the ambulance on scene. Shortly after, a semi truck struck Chief Gladney's vehicle from behind. Fellow first responders, including previous students, extricated Bryant and transported him to the hospital, where he was pronounced dead. Bryant left behind his wife, Jamie, and their son, Jack, as well as Bryant's oldest son, Shaun, and his wife, Elizabeth.

Bryant was a hard working paramedic for more than 25 years, later transitioning from the field into the classroom. Bryant enrolled in paramedic class shortly after high school and worked for several EMS organizations throughout the state of Missouri.

In 2011, Bryant transitioned to the Boone County Fire Protection District, where he grew the EMS Education program into one of the top programs in Missouri, attracting students from throughout the region. His knowledge and passion for paramedicine made him an exceptional teacher and leader in the fire district.

Chief Gladney's heart was in teaching. He influenced the lives of countless EMT and Paramedic students through his work with the training program. His students now work for various EMS and fire agencies throughout the country, where they are making a positive impact on their communities and neighbors.

In 2022, Bryant's family created the Bryant Gladney Foundation to honor his memory and continue his passion. Our mission is to inspire future generations of EMS Providers to be exceptional caregivers by providing education and scholarship opportunities. Since then, we have been able to establish the Bryant Gladney Paramedic Education Scholarship, which has awarded \$27,000 in tuition scholarships to 26 paramedic students around the country, and will award another \$15,000 in 2025. We have also begun planning the inaugural All-Star EMS Conference, which will be hosted in Columbia, MO, in 2025.





Texas EMS Educators Summit April 19-20, 2024, Galveston, Texas




